We have received articles from different on various topics like including aspects of Gynecology, Intensive care unit as well as Medical services needs of pregnant ladies etc.

In year 2020, IPCCOG has published more than 10 articles from different topics of Obstetrics and Gynecology. The Journal Impact Factor is 1.02. The Journal has published articles on topic like Prematurity, Prolonged Pregnancy, and their uses and effects, Postpartum Hemorrhage, Caesarean Delivery Rates etc.

During the year 2020, the Journal Critical Care obstetrics and Gynecology has received many articles. During 2020 around 10-11 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and 10 of those were accepted. In the 6 issues of Volume 6 published during the year 2020, a total of 10 articles were published (at an average of 6-7 articles per issue) of which, 50% articles were by foreign authors. journal has been maintained to 6-8 weeks of time.
